Description

After completing some royal portraits in Romania, Healy departed for New York accompanied by Edith, Kathleen, and his wife. This is likely when the portrait of Edith was executed. Most of Healy's portraits of his family stayed in the family or were bought by private collectors. This portrait was not shown by the National Academy.
