Dear Margit Rowell, Chief Curator, Department of Drawings, Museum of Modern Art:

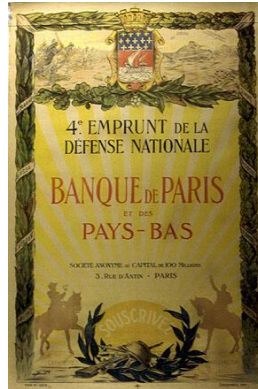
We're thrilled that you have managed to redefine the still life to exclude women and artists of color from the practice.

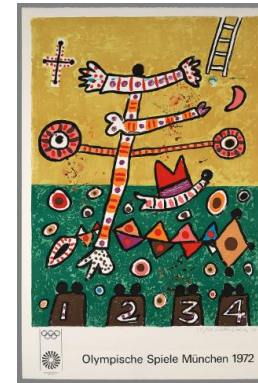
